Program Review

Objectives

- ❖ An opportunity for teens who have at least three years of 4-H experience to be recognized for the leadership they have dedicated to the Johnson County 4-H Program.
- ❖ 4-H'ers who earn the title of Mr. or Miss 4-H should actively seek opportunities to promote the Johnson County 4-H Program.

Basic Requirements

- ❖ 13, as of January 1 (4-H age)
- ❖ Completed 3 or more years of 4-H
- ❖ Submit application and appropriate documents
 - ❖ Including a digital photo, resume and signed commitment letter

Application Process

- ❖ Application Requirements
 - ❖ 30 points
- ❖ Public Presentation
 - ❖ 40 points
- ❖ Interview Requirements
 - ❖ 30 points

Application Requirements

- ❖ 30 points out of 100 points total
- ❖ Includes one page resume
 - ❖ Refer to the sample resume
- ❖ Completed application
 - ❖ Should be typed
 - ❖ Should not exceed 3 pages, including the first pg

Public Presentation

- ❖ 40 points out of 100 points total
- ❖ 10-minute presentation
- ❖ Promoting 4-H
- ❖ Audience will include a panel of 3 judges and family members, fellow 4-H members, etc.
- ❖ LCD projector, table and easel will be provided

Tips for your **Public Presentation**

- ❖ Power Point or visual aids are acceptable
- ❖ Utilize your full 10 minutes
- ❖ Avoid use of note cards or notes
- ❖ Share your personal experiences
- ❖ Practice with your family, friends and mentors before the actual judging
- ❖ Be yourself and have FUN!

Interview

- ❖ 30 points out of 100 points total
- ❖ Interview with a panel of 3 judges
- ❖ Questions will be on 4-H, leadership and citizenship experiences
- ❖ Maximum of 10 minutes

Tips for your **Interview**

- ❖ Share your personal experiences
- ❖ Maintain eye contact with judges
- ❖ Talk slowly and clearly
- ❖ Practice with your family, friends and mentors before the actual judging
- ❖ Relax, be yourself and have FUN!
