- Always helpful to include a relevant picture (make sure you have permission!)
- Should be appropriate and timely

4. Where to Submit Your Articles

- Clover Clips 4H Newsletter (submit to Christin in the Extension Office)
- Johnson County Gazette has been open to submissions from 4Hers
- The Gardner News allows 4H articles for their Fair edition in July
- Other local Newsletters or online sources

5. How to Earn Your Reporter Pin

- You must submit at least 6 articles during the 4H year (any source)
- They do not have to be published, only submitted
- Compile a Reporter's Notebook
- 3-ring Binder
- Include:
 - a. Original articles and when/where submitted
 - b. Copies of the publication (if published) with information on when and where it was published
